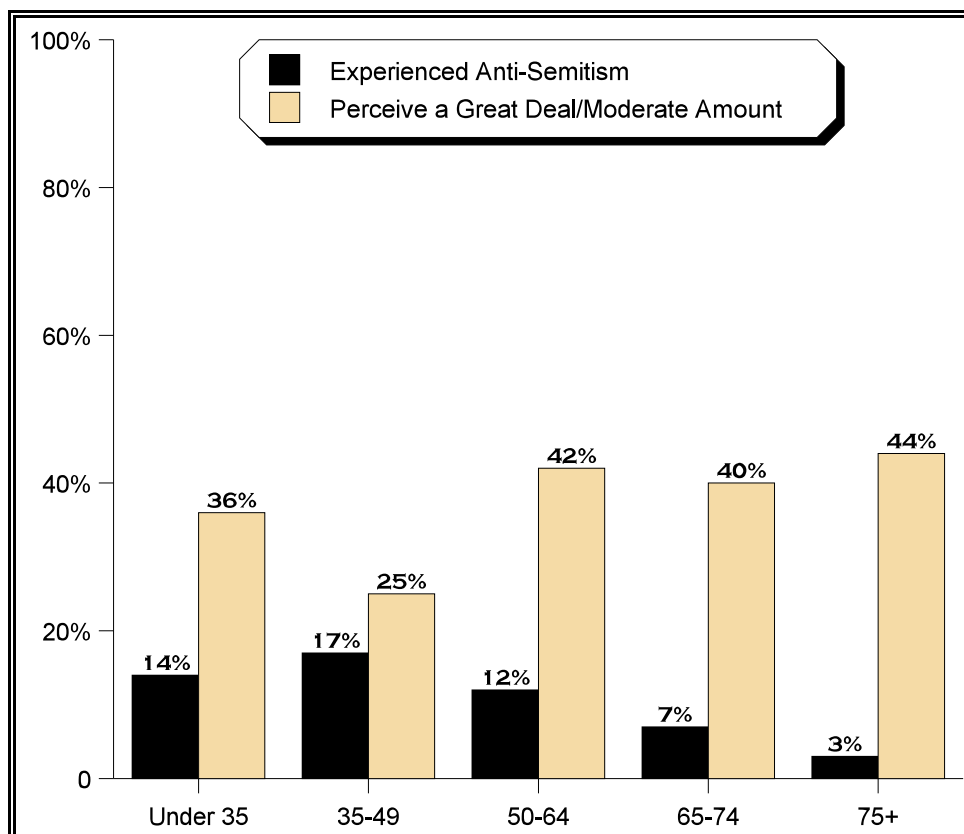


ANTI-SEMITISM

Anti-Semitism is a major concern of the American Jewish community. Overall, 7% (5,256 households) of Jewish respondents in South Palm Beach personally experienced anti-Semitism in Palm Beach County in the past year. The respondent defined anti-Semitism for himself/herself. The 7% is the lowest of about 30 comparison Jewish communities and compares to 13% in Miami, 11% in Broward, and 9% in West Palm Beach. The 7% compares to 11% in 1995.

▣ 9% of households with Jewish children age 6-17 contain a Jewish child age 6-17 who experienced anti-Semitism in Palm Beach County in the past year, mainly at school. The 9% is the second lowest of about 25 comparison Jewish communities and compares to 28% in West Palm Beach, 16% in Broward, and 9% in Miami.

▣ 9% of respondents perceive a great deal of anti-Semitism in Palm Beach County; 31%, a moderate amount; 33%, a little; and 26%, none at all. In total, 41% of respondents perceive a great deal or moderate amount of anti-Semitism in Palm Beach County. The 41% is below average among about 35 comparison Jewish communities and compares to 54% in Broward and 49% in Miami. The 41% compares to 51% in 1995.
